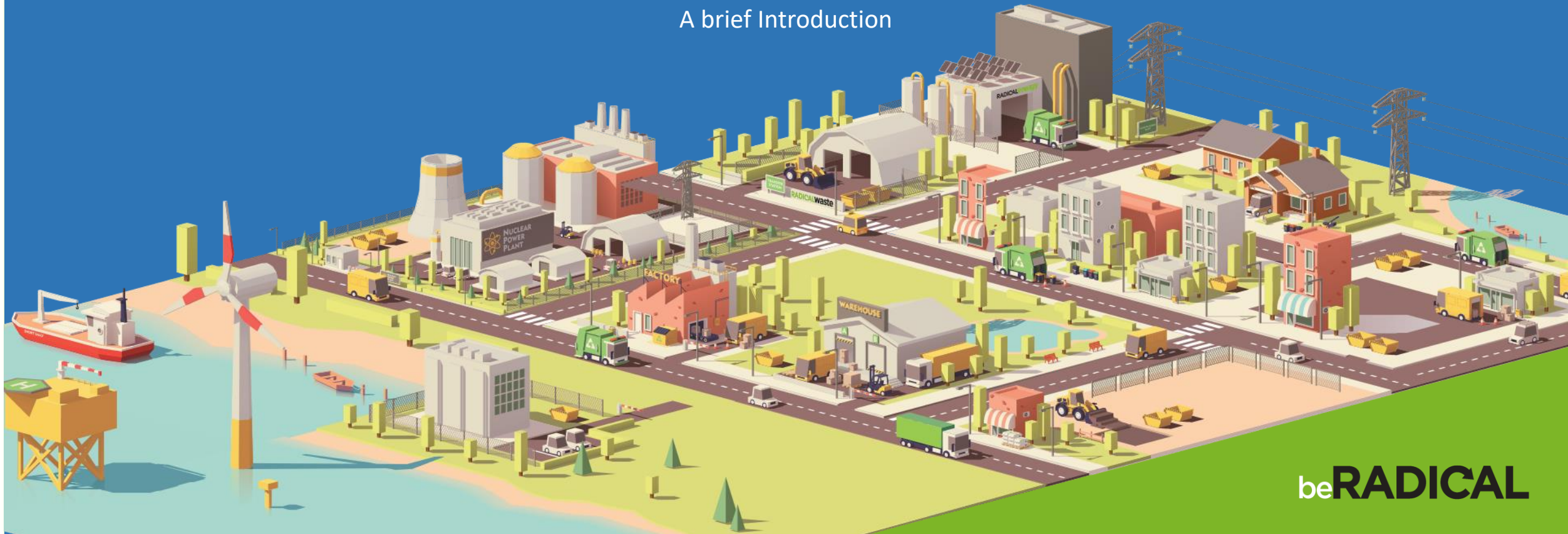

- We don't just aim to be self-sufficient, but to push up to 1MWE back into the Grid via our onsite substation.
- This will create an effective solution to end of line waste avoiding any unnecessary vehicle movement.
- We've made large strides towards building a green hydrogen plant alongside our EFW plant and in conjunction with our existing solar array, we're well on our way to becoming a truly Net-Zero waste business.
- Our plans for the future include replicating this model of energy production and high-quality waste processing on other sites around the UK. We are in dialogue with other stakeholders and investors to help make this a reality.
