Summary of presentations/guest speakers

- Steve Beel, chief executive, Freeport East expanded on the Freeport as more than just a
 tax and customs opportunity. The Freeport NZ Plan sets out an ambitious project to
 produce hydrogen as a green fuel the opportunities are provided locally to support
 production as well as a strong end user network. The hub therefore can support
 international trade and go a long way to reduce emissions such as diesel fuel
 consumption.
- Nadine Daines, head of marketing & communications, TCP Group set out how hydrogen energy is being used in commercial applications across a range of sectors that need high power, portable and clean solutions that TCP provides.
- Energy Advice Service: Darren Ivey, senior engagement advisor, Department for Energy Security & Net Zero updated the group about the pilot of the EAS in the Midlands, and the forthcoming Energy Transformation Fund that is in development.
